The Catholic Charities Hunger Project provides a free monthly supply of food for those living on a fixed income —age 55+ or those with disabilities of any age.

- Age 55+ or disabled
- Low income
- Eligible for food stamps (All head of household must be receiving Food Stamps or have a denial letter to be certified.)

Must also provide:

- Proof of address (Current Rental Agreement or at least two bills in applicant's name with that address.)
- Photo ID
- Proof of household bills
